

CLUB RULES

1. Only Members, members of their household, and their guests are entitled to utilize the Club facilities.
2. Members are responsible for their conduct and that of members of their household and their guests.
3. Members will be held liable for any property damage to the Club willfully and/or negligently caused by themselves, members of their household, or their guests. This includes private parties.
4. Guests must be accompanied by their sponsoring member. The same individual cannot be a guest more than twice per month, regardless of the sponsoring member(s).
5. Guests using the Club facilities are required to pay a guest's fee of \$5.00 for the pool and \$5.00 for the tennis facilities. For your convenience, a guest fee punch card for the pool may be purchased and kept on file in the lifeguard office. The cost is \$25.00 for a 6-punch card, buy 5 and get 1 free.
6. No alcoholic beverages are permitted on Club premises.
7. The use of illegal drugs or narcotics will not be tolerated.
8. No pets are allowed on that portion of the Club grounds which is fence-enclosed.
9. No glass bottles or containers shall be brought onto the grounds.
10. Trash, bottles, cans, and paper products are to be disposed of properly. If you or your children created the trash, it is your responsibility to clean it up. Please help keep **YOUR** Club attractive.
11. No loitering is allowed in front of the Club in the parking lot area.
12. Rough play, foul language, and inappropriate public displays of affection are prohibited.
13. Ice from the Ice Machine is for on-premises use only.
14. Phones are not to be used for long distance calls. Personal local calls should be limited to one minute.
15. The Tennis Pro is accountable to the President of the Club and is empowered to interpret and enforce the rules of the Club on a daily basis. He and his staff will attempt to make your experience at Oakwood pleasurable, safe, and considerate of others.
16. **Rules of Discipline:**
 - a. First offense: Verbal warning followed by a "time out".
 - b. Second offense: One-day suspension from use of the Club facilities.
 - c. Third offense: One-week suspension from the use of the Club facilities.
 - d. Fourth offense: Board review to determine disciplinary action.
 - e. Guests who refuse to abide by the Club rules will be asked to leave the Club immediately.
17. No persons younger than 15 years old shall be left unaccompanied by an adult at the club after pool hours during the summer or after 8 p.m. during the non-pool season.

18. Due to the club's security alarm system, do not go into the gated area or any of the buildings between 10:30 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.

POOL RULES

1. All persons entering the pool must register with the office employee at the pool entrance.
 - a. Members must register with the office employee any guest(s) and must pay the appropriate fee of \$3.00 per guest.
 - b. The same individual cannot be a guest more than twice per month, regardless of the sponsoring member(s).
 - c. Any member who fails to properly check in at the entrance or fails to have his guest properly register is subject to a \$5.00 fine, additional to the guest fee.
 - d. A member bringing more than five (5) guests at one time is considered a party and must be scheduled as such.

2. Persons with skin disorders or other infections must not enter the pools.

3. Please shower before entering the pool.

4. The following general pool safety rules must be observed:
 - a. Persons not in swimming attire are not to use the pool. No cutoffs, gym, or tennis shorts are allowed.
 - b. Play pens are not permitted in pool area.
 - c. Food and refreshments are to be consumed only at the poolside tables.
 - d. With the exception of spectacles and sunglasses, no items made of or containing glass are permitted in the pool enclosures.
 - e. Smoking is not permitted in the pool area or within the clubhouse.
 - f. Running on the pool decks or in the bathhouse is prohibited. Holding someone else's head under the water is prohibited.
 - g. Jumping or diving from the sides of the pool is not allowed in the diving area and near the pool steps. Jumping/diving is allowed in deep well when boards are closed.
 - h. Small balls, inner tubes, inflatable rafts and rings, if deemed objectionable or dangerous by pool personnel, will not be permitted in the pool area.
 - i. Starting blocks are to be used for swim practice and meets only.
 - j. Lifeguard instructions must be obeyed.

5. Children over 4 years of age are not to use the wading pool.

6. The wading pool is not supervised by lifeguards. Children in the wading pool are the complete responsibility of the person accompanying them, and are not to be left unattended.

7. No child under 10 years old is to be left at the pool unaccompanied by an adult.

8. Babysitters must be at least 12 years old; exceptions must be approved by lifeguards.

9. When lightning or threatening thunder appears, the pool will be cleared. The lifeguards on duty will be responsible for resumption of swimming based on their judgment.

10. DIVING AREA RULES:

- a. Only one person is permitted on the diving board at a time.
- b. No running or multiple bouncing on the board.
- c. Hand stands are not permitted.
- d. Walking backward on the board is not permitted.
- e. Hanging from the board is not permitted.
- f. Divers waiting in line must wait at the bottom of the ladder.
- g. Dive from the front of the board only.
- h. Diving when a swimmer is in the diving area is prohibited.
- i. Exit the diving area promptly by using the ladder.
- j. Children wearing flotation devices may not use the diving boards.
- k. Members who wish to use the high dive must be at least as tall as the fourth rung of the high dive ladder and be at least 6 years old.
- l. New swimmers or children learning to go off the diving board — parents are allowed to wait in the water while touching the ladder on the side of the pool to assist children if needed.

PARTY RULES

1. Only an Oakwood member in good standing may request to schedule a party. This member must be present and is responsible for all guests and any damage that may occur as a result of the party.
2. All parties are to be held within the fenced pool area. The tennis courts and clubhouse are off limits unless special arrangements have been made with the Tennis Pro. The fees for this are additional to all party fees and will be set depending on the number of participants and the type of need.
3. All rules that apply for normal pool hours apply for parties even if the party is scheduled when the pool is closed. The lifeguards must and will maintain order and any member or guest not conforming to Club rules will be subject to the same disciplinary action as with normal operation. Additionally, music that is loud or contains offensive language is prohibited, as is throwing food or ice. For your safety, the lifeguards are in charge and their decisions will be respected.

PRIVATE PARTIES

1. Private parties are limited to available Tuesday afternoons during the regular summer schedule. Parties may also be scheduled after the pool opens part time in May, and after full time closing during Aug./Sept.
2. Each Party must be sponsored by an active member with an active bond number.
3. Youth programs may schedule private parties with the following stipulations:
 - There must be an active Oakwood member within the organization to sponsor the party. The sponsor must attend the duration of the party.
4. Normal operating hours and regularly scheduled team practices will not be adjusted to accommodate private parties.
5. Team events have priority to Tuesday night availability.

No private parties will be scheduled on days in which a home swim meet is scheduled. No open parties will be scheduled during Wednesday home dive meets.

6. Parties are subject to lifeguard availability and all lifeguards must be employees of Oakwood.

7. Tuesday party time availability:

2 hour parties – 2:30pm – 4:30pm; 5:00pm – 7:00pm; 6:30pm – 8:30pm

3 hour parties – 2:30pm – 5:50pm; 6:00pm – 9:00pm

Lifeguards will open the gates 15 minutes early for set-up and clear the pool at end time for clean-up.

8. Party fees*

Pool Rental:

\$100.00/2hr party up to 30 people

\$150.00/3hr party up to 30 people

\$2.00/ea for additional participants

Lifeguards: Minimum requirement of 2 lifeguards for each party

\$50.00 - 2 lifeguards for 2hr party up to 24 swimmers

\$75.00 - 3 lifeguards for 2hr party up to 50 swimmers

\$100.00 - 4 lifeguards for 2hr party for 50+ swimmers

\$80.00 - 2 lifeguards for 3hr party up to 24 swimmers

\$120.00 - 3 lifeguards for 3hr party up to 50 swimmers

\$160.00 - 4 lifeguards for 3hr party for 50+ swimmers

9. The pool rental fee must be paid in advance of the party. The party is not confirmed until payment is received.

PARTIES DURING POOL HOURS

1. Only one party at a time may be scheduled during pool hours, for a maximum of two hours, with a maximum of twenty (20) nonmember guests, including adults.

2. Parties that are scheduled during the time when the pool is open to members will be charged \$3.00 per non-member, including non-swimmers.

3. A member bringing in more than five (5) guests at one time is considered a party and must be scheduled as such.
